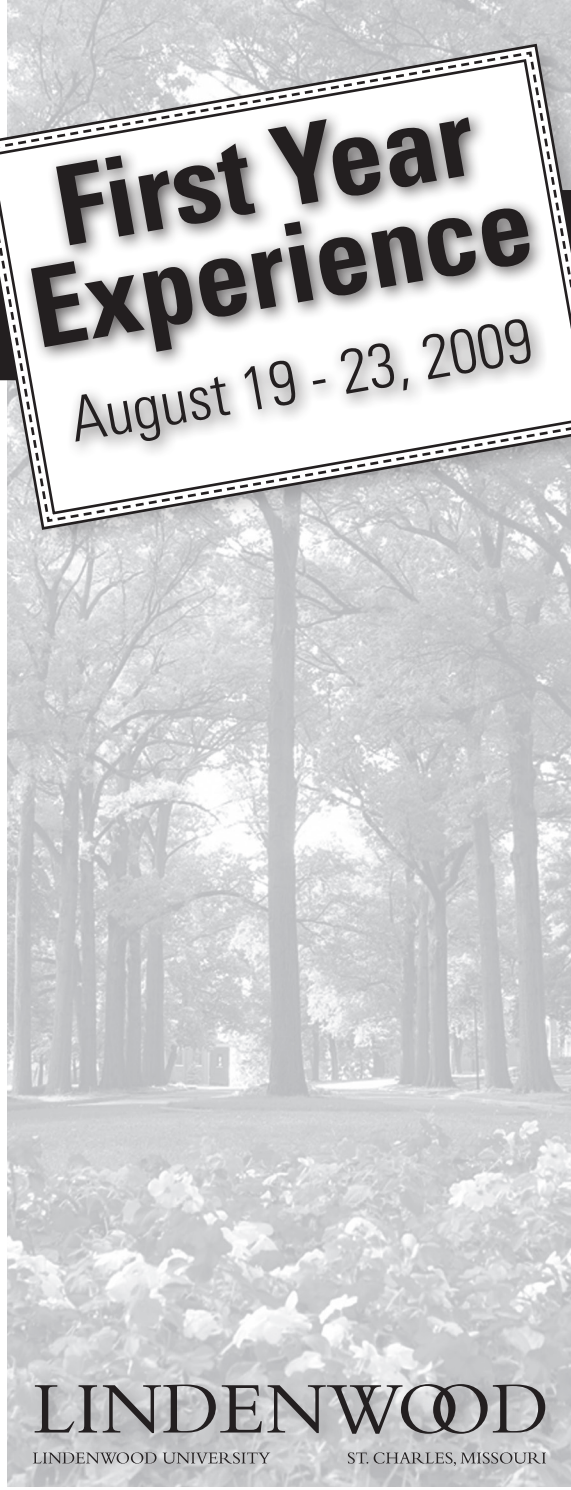

The Office of First-Year Programs is committed to providing first-year students with the support and resources needed to have a successful transition to Lindenwood University. All new first-year students are required to attend the First-Year Experience (FYE) in order to be prepared to succeed academically, socially, and personally.

Who are First-Year Students?

First-year students are traditional undergraduate students who are attending college for the first time and transfer students with fewer than 24 transferable hours who have NOT completed a Freshmen Seminar course. All 2009 high school graduates, regardless of the amount of earned college credits, are considered first-year students.

During FYE you will:

- Meet other first year students
- Learn about key resources
- Meet your faculty advisor
- Gather information about life on campus
- Participate in exciting and informative activities

Parent Experience

Parents are encouraged to attend the Parent Experience on Wednesday, August 19, from 2:00 – 4:30 p.m. The event will kick-off with “Coffee with the President” from 2:00-3:00 p.m. Following this event, parents will have the opportunity to learn about the academic and student resources available to your child, interact with key administrators, meet other parents and family members, and ask questions specifically related to your child. The Experience will culminate with a barbecue (\$8.00/person) for parents to eat with their student and say “farewell”. Tickets will be purchased on August 19 – **DO NOT SEND MONEY NOW.**
